CAT 2016 A MIXED EXPERIENCE

The much awaited Common Admission Test (CAT) brought out mixed reactions from students who wrote it on Sunday. While some say it was easier than last year, others say it was not. Abhijeet Mohandas who took the exam on Sunday for the third time found the Verbal Ability section easy whereas the Quantitative Analysis was totally different from last year. "The Data Interpretation was moderately easy. I think scoring a 90 percentile will not be a big deal for students."

On the other hand, the test was not a cake walk for Jheelam Sen. "I found the DI section very tricky as some questions were unclear. With the kind of preparation I had, answering more than 13 out of 34 questions was not possible for me but the VA section was easier than expected."

According to Gautam Puri, co-founder of Career launcher, Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension was similar as last year and students have completed the section with five minutes to spare. "The VA/RC section was easy and it was so similar to the last year's paper that students finished it with five minutes to spare. Around 30 attempts out of the 34 questions can be expected from this section by students."
