BENGALURU: The data interpretation and logical reasoning (DILR) section was 'far too difficult' for many candidates who appeared for the Common Admission Test (CAT)-2016 on Sunday. Around 1.95 lakh students took the test conducted by the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) in two slots across 138 centres in the country.

"The section on DILR was very tricky. I had to leave 15 questions unanswered," said Divyendu Sharma who wrote the test for the first time.

Gagan Rao, who had taken the test last year, said the DILR section was more analytical than the last year's. "I ended up spending too much time on each question," he rued.
